Rules:

- FVSA reserves the right to cancel or combine classes.
- Proper attire required for all classes. Juniors are required to wear approved headgear.
- Ribbons 1st through 6th awarded in each class. Daily Champion and Reserve Champion awarded in each division. You must be entered in the entire division to be eligible for highpoint. Highpoints are by horse/rider combination.
- Short Stirrup riders are eleven (11) years and under, Children's riders age as described in class titles, and Adult riders are nineteen (19) years and over. Age is as of January 1st, 2005.
- The OTTB (Off Track Thoroughbred) Hunter Hack class will consist of a hack portion and an over fences portion of the class. ALL proceeds from this class will go to ReRun Illinois.
- Stalls are limited. Please call or email to reserve your stalls. If bedding is desired, please bring your own.
- Judges decision is final. No entries refunded. Riders must be present to accept awards.
